Credential 1 Mindset

This introductory credential covers the key concepts of UDL, such as variability, barriers, and expert learning, and serves as the perfect starting point for a UDL credential journey.



Credential 2 Analysis

In this credential, participants analyze a real-world scenario and determine how the design reduces barriers, supports learner variability, and connects to the UDL Guidelines.



Credential 3 Application

Participants plan, implement, gather feedback, and revise their own design of a learning experience (i.e., lesson) using UDL. This credential supports participants to work through the UDL design process, or the intentional planning of the goal, assessment(s), materials, methods, and physical environment.
